# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TULARE MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT, HELD AT THE OFFICES OF THE DISTRICT, MEFFORD FIELD, TULARE, CALIFORNIA ON THE 13th DAY OF AUGUST 2019, AT THE HOUR OF 1:00 P.M. OF SAID DAY

Present at the meeting called at 1:00 p.m. at the place above designated were: Robert Clark, presiding, Pat Nunes, Chuck Mayer, Stan Creelman, and Robert Uchita at 1:06 p.m. Charlie Pitigliano was absent. Also present at the Board Meeting were John Avila, District Manager, and Chad M. Lew, counsel for the District.

#### Agenda Item No. 1: Citizen Comments.

Robert Clark opened the floor to citizen comments, but there were no comments from the public.

Agenda Item No. 2: Review Minutes of July 9, 2019 Board of Trustees Meeting.

The minutes of the meeting held on July 9, 2019, were presented to the board in writing and reviewed. Upon a motion made by Pat Nunes, seconded by, Chuck Mayer, and unanimously carried, the minutes of the meeting held on July 9, 2019, were approved as presented.

Robert Uchita now present.

Agenda Item No. 3: Payment of Check Number 5849 - 5891, Electronic Fund Transfers (EFTPS) from Union Bank to the IRS for Social Security, Medicare and Federal Tax Payments, and Union Bank Charges and Credits.

The board members reviewed the District's Union Bank checking account, check numbers 5849 - 5891, the electronic fund transfers (EFTPS) for payment of Social Security, Medicare and Federal Tax Payments to the IRS, and the electronic debit payments from the District's Union Bank account. Upon a motion duly made by Chuck Mayer, seconded by Stan Creelman, and unanimously carried, the Union Bank checking account, check numbers 5849 - 5891, the electronic fund transfers (EFTPS) for payment of Social Security, Medicare and Federal Tax Payments to the IRS, and the electronic debit payments from the District's Union Bank checking account were approved.

#### Agenda Item No. 4: Implementation of Fiscal Year 18/19 Audit.

John advised the board that the audit of the 2018/2019 fiscal year is underway by Adair & Evans.

## Agenda Item No. 5: Discussion and Decision on OPEB Actuarial Report.

John presented and discussed the General Contract for Services between the District and GovInvest Inc., for the preparation of a 2019 GASB 75 Alternative Measurement Method report for the cost of \$3,100.00. After some discussion, it was unclear whether the District is required to file the GASB 75 at this time. The board instructed the District Manager to confer with the auditor to determine if the GASB 75 was in fact required to be completed this fiscal year. John indicated that he would research the matter with the District's Auditor and place the matter on next month's agenda.

Agenda Item No. 6: PERS Unfunded Liability Statement.

John reviewed with the board the District's CalPers unfunded liabilty.

Agenda Item No. 7: CalPers Investment Returns for Fiscal Year 2018-2019.

John reviewed with the board CalPers report of its investment returns for fiscal year 2018-2019. CalPers reported a preliminary 6.7% net return on investments for fiscal year 2018-2019, although CalPers was unable to achieve its desired 7% actuarial return target for this fiscal year.

Agenda Item No. 8: Discussion and Decision to Accept Resolution 2019-001 - CalPers Health Region Change.

John reviewed with the board Resolution No. 2019-001 - Fixing the Employer Contribution at Unequal Amounts For Employees and Annuitants Under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act. John advised the board this resolution was necessary because CalPers changed the District's region and the resolution would reflect that change. Upon a motion duly made by Chuck Mayer, seconded by Robert Uchita, and unanimously carried, the board approved and adopted Resolution 2019-001 - Fixing the Employer Contribution at Unequal Amounts For Employees and Annuitants Under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act.

#### Agenda Item No. 9: West Nile Human Cases in District (2).

John advised that the District has been notified that there have been two documented cases of human West Nile Virus within the District, as of July 2019.

#### Agenda Item No. 10: CSDA Meeting at Fresno Irrigation District 7/31/19.

John advised the board that he attended the CSDA meeting in Fresno on July 31, 2019, wherein the topic discussed was essential communications for special districts.

#### Agenda Item No. 11: Meeting with Tulare Cemetery District Board 7/31/19.

John advised the board that the District set traps at the Tulare Cemetery on Blackstone and trapped in excess of 3,000 mosquitos, so the issue was discussed with the cemetery district staff and they were given recommendations to reduce the mosquito breeding which included reducing water use to stop pooling of water and emptying water containers that operate as mosquito breeding sources. The cemetery district staff indicated that they were receptive to reducing the water use, but that the cemetery board would not allow it. John advised then that he contacted the cemetery board and asked to be placed on the agenda for their next meeting so that he could discuss the issue directly with the board. John attended the cemetery board meeting and addressed the results of the trapping and also TMAD recommendations to reduce the mosquito population at the cemetery which are to reduce water usage and to ensure that the containers at the cemetery are routinely emptied of any water, and the cemetery board was receptive and indicated that they would implement the requested recommendations.

#### Agenda Item No. 12: Monolith Properties - Warning and Response.

John reviewed with the board the District's Warning letter to Monolith regarding the overgrown ponding basin at the Oak Estates mobile home part, and also Monolith's response dated July 17, 2019. John reports that Monolith complied with the District's request to clean the ponding basin and remove the over grown trees and shrubs so that the ponding basin can now be accessed and treated

by District staff, when necessary.

#### Agenda Item No. 13: Manager's Report.

- a) Activity at the District Aedes and Culex John reported that this season continues to experience higher mosquito populations within the District which is creating more service requests this season. John advised that so far this season the District has recieved 290 service requests, and that at this same time last year the District only received 37 service requests.
- b) First Invasive Teleconference 2019 John reported about his participation on the 1<sup>st</sup> Invasive Aedes Telephone Conference. In the conference, the District's discussed and shared their respective invasive Aedes surveillance and treatment strategies.
- c) How Fast Mosquitos Multiply John provided the board with a spread sheet that he created that illustrates how quickly mosquito populations can multiply.

#### Agenda Item No. 14: Meeting Adjourned.

There being no further business to come before the board, upon a motion duly made by Chuck Mayer, seconded by Stan Creelman, and unanimously carried, the special meeting was adjourned at 2:07 p.m.

#### Weekly Update

#### Humans

#### West Nile virus

A total of 5 human cases of West Nile virus (WNV) illness were reported this week from 4 counties: Los Angeles (1), Orange (1), Stanislaus (2), and Tulare (1). This is the first WNV case reported from Orange County this year. In 2019, 62 WNV human cases have been reported from 13 counties. Of the 62 reported cases, 38 (61%) were classified as neuroinvasive disease and 2 (3.2%) fatalities have been reported. The median age of the individuals is 57 years (range: 15–93 years) and 37 (60%) are male. Dates of symptom onset range from May 12 to August 18. In addition to the 62 cases, 14 asymptomatic infections have also been reported from Butte (1), El Dorado (1), Kern (3), Madera (1), San Bernardino (4), San Joaquin (1), Shasta (1), Stanislaus (1), and Sutter (1) counties. At this time last year, 56 human cases had been reported from 21 counties.

#### St. Louis encephalitis virus

No new cases were reported this week. In 2019, 3 human cases of St. Louis encephalitis virus (SLEV) disease have been reported from 2 counties: Fresno (1) and Imperial (2). Of the 3 reported cases, 3 (100%) were classified as neuroinvasive disease. The median age of the individuals is 49 years and dates of symptom onset range from July 14 to July 27. No fatalities have been reported.

#### **Dead Birds**

A total of 12 WNV positive dead birds were reported this week from 6 counties: Contra Costa (1), Kern (1), Orange (1), Sacramento (4), San Bernardino (3), and Yolo (2). These are the first WNV positive birds in Contra Costa, San Bernardino, and Yolo counties this year. In 2019, a total of 103 WNV positive dead birds have been reported from 16 counties. At this time last year, 422 WNV positive dead birds had been reported from 18 counties.

#### **Mosquito Pools**

#### West Nile virus

A total of 299 WNV positive mosquito pools were reported this week from 18 counties: Butte (5), Fresno (35), Kern (4), Kings (13), Los Angeles (11), Madera (6), Merced (8), Orange (66), Placer (3), Riverside (7), Sacramento (5), San Bernardino (6), San Joaquin (58), Stanislaus (8), Sutter (1), Tulare (54), Yolo (8), and Yuba (1). In 2019, a total of 2,815 WNV positive mosquito pools have been reported from 24 counties. At this time last year, 1,606 WNV positive mosquito pools had been reported from 28 counties.

#### St. Louis encephalitis virus

A total of 46 SLEV positive mosquito pools were reported this week from 8 counties: Fresno (5), Kern (2), Kings (1), Merced (1), Orange (1), Riverside (22), Stanislaus (2), and Tulare (12). **This is the first detection of SLEV activity in Merced and Orange counties this year.** In 2019, a total of 224 SLEV positive mosquito pools have been reported from 9 counties: Fresno (41), Imperial (3), Kern (50), Kings (2), Merced (1), Orange (1), Riverside (56), Stanislaus (3), and Tulare (67). At this time last year, 295 SLEV positive mosquito pools had been reported from 8 counties.

#### Sentinel Chickens

A total of 28 WNV seroconversions were reported this week from 7 counties: Butte (13), Colusa (4), Contra Costa (1), Merced (4), Sutter (3), Tehama (2), and Yuba (1). This is the first detection of WNV activity in

Colusa, Contra Costa, and Tehama counties this year. In 2019, 81 WNV positive chickens have been reported from 11 counties. At this time last year, 104 WNV positive chickens had been reported from 13 counties.



RE: Assembly Bill 1486 (Ting) - Oppose Unless Amended [As Amended June 27, 2019]

**Dear Assembly Member Ting:** 

The Tulare Mosquito Abatement District is respectfully opposed to Assembly Bill 1486 unless it is amended to address our concerns. AB 1486 would impose onerous new requirements on public agencies attempting to dispose of their land. We are a small Vector Control District in the Central Valley of California covering over 560 square miles of territory including cities and town.

AB 1486 places new restrictions on and expands the types of agencies subject to the Surplus Land Act (SLA), by adding sewer, water, utility, and local and regional park districts, joint powers authorities, successor agencies to former redevelopment agencies, housing authorities, and other political subdivisions of this state to the list of agencies that are mandated to follow certain requirements before disposing of surplus land.

AB 1486 would apply the requirements of the SLA to all land owned by a public agency no longer necessary for the agency's "use." AB 1486 would also narrowly define the term "use" in a manner that does not contemplate the countless instances where a special district owns land for a public purpose but does not use the land in its day to day operations, or for sites for future facilities that are also used for an interim purpose that generates revenue for the district. We request that the bill be amended to define "surplus land" as land used for achieving the agency's public use rather than merely governmental operations, and that the restrictive limitations applied to the term "use" as proposed in Section 54221(c)(2) be deleted.

AB 1486 also would require a special district to notice the availability of the property prior to participating in even informal negotiations to dispose of the land. There are many reasons for a district to have informal negotiations, particularly if the disposition is time sensitive. Informal discussions can provide a public agency the opportunity to closely consider the viability of the land for the agency's public purpose, available alternatives, and a good sense of potential market value. The exceptions included in the bill for "participating in negotiations" fail to address the scope of informal negotiations sometimes necessary to analyze the unique potential, condition, and use of surplus property, which can go beyond simple appraisal or value study.

AB 1486 would impose an onerous penalty of 50% of the final value of the land disposed where a public agency did not comply with the requirements of the SLA. This could be a devastating blow to a small local agency that makes an error. A 50 percent penalty could substantially harm an agency's finances, and by extension the residents and customers they serve. This disproportionately high penalty also leaves no discretion to assess appropriateness of penalties that are gradually increased for cause. Therefore, we request that Section 54230.5 be amended to make the provision more reasonable, while still allowing substantial maximum penalties up to 30% of the final sale price of the land.

Finally, AB 1486 would create costly reporting requirements for special districts, even for properties that have not been designated as suitable for residential housing pursuant to a housing element.

Our District is currently in the midst of one of the worst mosquito seasons I've seen in my 30 years of Mosquito Control. We are facing an unprecedented amount of mosquito activity and virus transmission here along with dealing with an invasive species of mosquito never before dealt with here in the Central Valley up until the last 4 years. We currently lease our property and land at the local airport and if the city is forced to make this land available to another agency other than ours it would create a hardship in a time when peoples health and lives are at stake.

We respectfully request AB 1486 be amended to address these issues. Our opposition is not a challenge to the need for affordable housing, but a validation of the need for local flexibility when it comes to proper governmental land use management.

For these reasons, The Tulare Mosquito Abatement District respectfully opposes AB 1486 unless it is amended.
